

Labour Participation Rate Summary

City of Kawartha Lakes and the County of Haliburton

The labour participation rate is calculated by dividing the the number of people with labour income by the total population within a specific age group for a specific year.



There are two observations from these graphs that should be noted:

1. When reviewing the labour participation rates by age group there is very little difference between the labour participation rates in the City of Kawartha Lakes (City) and the County of Haliburton (County) and the Province of Ontario. In their 20's, City and County residents are participating at a slightly greater rate than their provincial counterparts. Those from about 55 to 65 years of age are participating at a lower rate than those across the province.
2. If we look at the labour participation rate changes from 2007, we see a similar trend between the City, County and Ontario. Older workers are participating at a greater rate in the workforce and younger workers are participating at a lower rate. This trend is noticeable not only across the City and County, but across Ontario too.

Recent employment insurance data that shows younger workers are more likely to require access to employment insurance, along with this labour participation rate data indicate that younger workers are more likely to be in precarious work that is not consistent and they are experiencing difficulty finding employment.


























Labour Participation Rate
