Median Income (After Tax) Trends

The median is the value at which exactly half of all values fall above and below. The median income trends show that household incomes have been rising across all groups in both the City of Kawartha Lakes (City) and the County of Haliburton (County). These trends match those across the province as well.


However, there remains a persistent gap in incomes for families, whether couple led or headed by a lone parent, between families in the City and County when compared to the rest of the province.

These graphs do not take into account the location where income is earned, but only where people reside.



Exactly half of the incomes reported are greater than that amount, and half are less than that amount.




