"A critical difference is the amount of difference in neighbourhood's EDI vulnerability rate that is large enough to be considered significant for a particular number of children. Statistically significant change most likely represents a real shift in a neighbourhood's EDI vulnerability rate rather than a change influenced by measurement issues." - UBC Human Early Learning Partnership
